Fear of being abandoned. *Isaiah 43:2-3 (NLT)*

When you go through deep waters,
I will be with you.
When you go through rivers of difficulty,
you will not drown.
When you walk through the fire of oppression,
you will not be burned up;
the flames will not consume you.
³For I am the LORD, your God,

Fear of being hurt. *Heb. 13:6 (NIV)*

Fear of being rejected. *John 15:15-16*
